

The day will begin with a 10am Jubilee Mass with the Bishop, followed by Reconciliation and Adoration, a BYO picnic lunch at 12:30pm, Rosary led by the Bishop at 2pm, then a talk by Bishop Brian on the Jubilee with opportunity for Q and A, concluding with prayer and the Papal Blessing from the Bishop. Bishop Brian will then remain at Unanderra to celebrate the 6pm Vigil Mass that evening. Come along for all or part of this special day to learn more about the Jubilee, receive the Papal Blessing which is connected with the Jubilee Indulgence, and spend some time with the Bishop and other pilgrims from near and far.
